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TENANCE OF GROUNDS AND BUILDINGS IN R, NEW YORK, CEMETERY

The following are the specifications for installing concrete footer for headstones at the Bolivar, New York, Maple Lawn Cemetery for the period of two (2) years from April 1 2015 ó March 30, 2017, and are furnished to prospective bidders for the contract for such work. These specifications are to be considered a part of the contract upon its being awarded to the successful bidder:

Bid to be priced per surface sq./ft. of top of the footer. Example: Footer is 40ö wide by 14ö length and 36ö deep. The surface area of the top is 40ö x 14ö = 560ö, 560ö divided by 144ö (1 square foot) = 3.89 sq. ft.

Minimum dimensions of footer must be 2 inches greater than monument on all sides. (i.e. - 8ö x 36ö monument, minimum footer size 12ö x 40ö)

Maximum length to be based on owner request, but not to exceed 4 muless owner owns adjacent gravesite.

Depth to be 36 inches and created from solid concrete. No filler material added.

Top 3-1/2ö inches to be framed and have smooth finish. Frame to be removed after concrete has dried.

Top surface of concrete to be smooth finished.

Contractor to dig hole.

Contractor to supply all materials.

Contractor to remove all excess materials.

Contractor to backfill when necessary.

Back fill material to be supplied by Town of Bolivar.

- 2.) The contractor shall indemnify and save the Town of Bolivar harmless of and from all claims, actions, damages, and charges arising from the negligence or want of care of the contractor or his men of the prosecution of the work and shall obtain and maintain a policy of liability insurance providing personal injury coverage of at least ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (100,000) and property damages coverage of at least ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (100,000), a copy of which policy shall be furnished to the Bolivar Town Clerk upon being awarded the bid.
- 3.) Payment for the work will be made to the contractor by the individual requesting the footer. A copy of the original invoice for payment of work done, will be given to the Bolivar Town Clerk to verify the square footage formula.
- 4.) The contractor shall be prohibited from assigning, transferring, subletting or otherwise disposing of the contract to any other person, company, or corporations without the previous written consent of the Bolivar Town Board.
- 5.) The contract to be awarded shall provide that each mechanic, laborer and workmen employed by the contractor upon the work contemplated by the contract shall be paid not less than the prevailing rate of wage and supplements as provided for by Section 220 of the Labor Law of the State of New York, namely, there shall be paid to each employee engaging in such work, not less than the hourly wage rate and supplements for the trade or occupation as set forth in the Prevailing Rate Schedules annexed hereto. If any other occupation is required on this work, the prevailing rate of wage shall be paid, and the contractor shall request the Town Fiscal Officer for supplemental schedule covering such occupation.
