9. **REPORT OF TOWN OFFICIALS:**

- **Highway:** Highway Superintendent Brad Schiralli gave his report to the Board.
The new hire started June 23rd.
We helped the village paint the pool in June.
Completed the ditch work by the village barns.
Willow Brook and Foreman Hollow cold mix pave turned out good. We will be chip sealing these two roads first week of August.

Up-coming road projects.

- Start grading our dirt roads. Scott hollow, Stony lonesome. Wappsseny roads.
- Karen Leilous sluice pipe to be installed.
- 24-in sluice pipe and Scott hollow above Chris Taylor's we will be working on next week.
- Wappsseny access to horse run south intersection we will be working on. Need to check with the Association of Towns attorney team about this.

I would like to add Anderson Hollow and Scott Hollow, from the intersection of each road and Horse Run to the dirt portion. I would like to add it to our 2025 284 agreement. Grind these two roads and put crushed Bank run gravel in the grind. Then let them set over the winter, then do a three-course surface treat 2026.

Still waiting to hear back from New York State DOT to use chips money on a brush cutter head for the excavator.

Truck mileage and equipment hours were updated to the Board.

- **Town Clerk:** The Clerk report for June was handed out to the board. Check #2150 for \$852.26 was deposited in the General A Fund. Check #2151 for \$150.00 was deposited in the General B fund. Also issued by the clerk’s Office were 5 permanent handicap permits and 4 notarized documents.

- Chamber's yard: The Chamber's responded to the options available to help solve the pipe/water issue in their yard. They would like the ditch re-dug this fall and then next year fix the sluice pipe.
- Cemetery – There is a tree from a neighbor's property that fell and hangs over the cemetery property. Someone will try to contact the property owner to discuss removal of the fallen tree.
