- Highway: Highway Superintendent Brad Schiralli gave his report to the Board.

➤ Shared service agreement with NYS DOT

On a motion of Councilperson Iantorno, seconded by Councilperson MacDonell, to approve the shared service agreement with the NYS DOT for a period of two (2) years.

There is still no word on when our new 10-wheeler will get the box and plow equipment put on. The latest word from Valley Fab is they still are waiting on the hydraulic equipment for it.

Projects we have been working on for the town.

-Completely dug all the ditches on the Willow Brook Road.

-Replaced a 24-inch sluice pipe that runs under the road.

-Last fall the Allegany County DPW cut all the brush along the roadside.

-Graded all the shoulders and hauled the dirt away.

-Willow Brook is one of the roads we are doing a cold mixed pave on the second week of July.

-We are now doing ditch work on the Miller hollow road.

-Highway work scheduled for June.

-Start grading our dirt roads.

-Install 24-inch sluice pipe on the Scott Hollow Road.

-Installing DI and drainage at the pool bath House parking lot.

-Hauling in #67 stone from Franklinville for our cold mix pave.

-Have Junior Green start hauling #1a limestone from Leroy, the Dolomite pit, AKA Al - Blades and Sons. This Stone will be used for chip sealing.

For the past couple days, we have been trying to get the water working at the cemetery. We've come to the conclusion that we either have a hole in the suction line that comes from the spring box or the pump is not any good.

Dylan Dunbar and I went to measure up the sluice pipe that comes across by 353 South Main Street, the Chambers' residence. If we replace it with a 24-inch sluice pipe, and installing a DI box with a grate, the cost of this project is going to be around \$5600.

Cemetery garbage cans: For right now we are going to leave the garbage cans in the cemetery until we can get signs installed stating that this is carry in carry out cemetery.

I also want to discuss the purchase of a brush cutter head for the excavator at tonight's board meeting.

Truck mileage and equipment hours were updated for the Board.
