- **Highway:** Highway Superintendent Brad Schiralli gave his report to the Board.

Road projects we are currently working on.

- Ditching on dirt portion of Scott Hollow.
- Putting gravel down on Scott Hollow and grading.
- 18-inch crossover sluice pipe on Anderson Hollow.
- Replacement of undersized driveway sluice pipe on Anderson Hollow.
- Brush cutting on Scott Hollow

The new brush cutter works very well.

Trees in the cemetery have been taken down and all the debris has been cleaned up and hauled away.

The access road we are currently waiting for legal advice on the Wappseny Rd. before we can proceed with the work. Ed Adams is currently working on it personally. Not sure where to go from here as far as legal purposes. Do we continue to pursue an easement or transfer of land to make this section part of our road inventory?

Old plow blades we have in inventory are one set of old style and one set of the new.

Water in cemetery has not been fixed yet. Mr. Schiralli will go and test the water pump again to see if he can find the issue.

New truck ETA? December

Cost of doing Chambers 180 of sluice pipe is.

- day one... three town employees and excavator = 8 hrs
- day two ...one employee which was highway superintendent and excavator = 4 hrs
- day three... I used my personal tractor and box blade to grade the area to seed back = 3 hrs

Refinery Road Creek clean out. I've been talking with Allegany County Soil and Water Department about any permits needed if any, to clean out the creek on the Refinery Road. When we did the clean out between Route 417 and the Refinery Road before, no permits were needed. However, there are some changes and updates to the flood plain. I have been working with Emily Johnston from Allegany County Soil and Water and she had a meeting with New York State DEC to discuss our request yesterday. I'm still waiting to hear from Emily. I will try to contact her today on a follow-up. I may have the information for tonight's board meeting.
